Overlaying data from a broad scope of public-domain sources, combined with the ability to deep-dive to more locally nuanced views, provides the detailed insight required to plan programmes and allocate resource accordingly, along with the evidence to justify budgets, engage stakeholders and demonstrate empirical impact.

Housing use cases

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Child Asthma Programmes: the platform allowed cross-referencing of data on low appointment take-up with other data sets (such as UC claimants) to identify target areas for work.

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- Mental Health and Social Prescribing: the platform's multiple sources of data on mental health in adults and social prescribing figures enabled far more accurate predictions.
- Poor Quality Housing: users have used the platform to tighten their focus on specific conditions, such as families in homes affected by damp, mould, and poor ventilation.
- **Driving Efficiency and Impact:** VUIT data helps determine the optimal allocation of limited resources, such as the best location for peer support groups or 'kindness hub' pop-ups to deliver maximum community impact.
